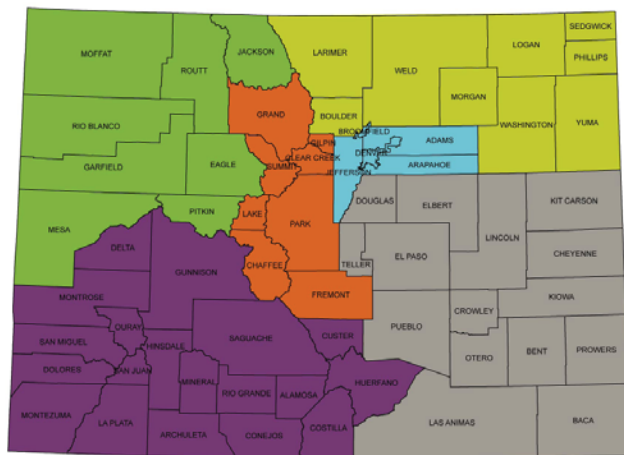


# Share **your views** on active living in Colorado!
